





## The Department of Louisiana American Legion M.C ''Mike'' Gehr Blue Cap Award

The M.C. "Mike" Gehr Blue Cap Award is a very prestigious award which is funded by the Gehr family and is awarded annually on the District and Department levels. Every Post in our Department has a hard-working, dependable and volunteering member who has served his/her Post for *at least 5 years* and is deserving of being nominated

- 1. Use the Blue form only. Please limit additional information to 2 typewritten pages and 2 photographs.
- 2. Any Post member, who is a former recipient of the award for the District, or the Post Commander, may nominate an individual from that Post for the award to the District Blue Cap Chair.
- 3. On the Post level former BLUE CAP recipients of the award should serve on the Post Selection Committee. The Post Selection Committee will have final approval of the Post Candidate. Only one nomination per Post is made to the District Blue Cap Chairman, by the assigned date. This application must be sent to the District Blue Cap Chair, no later than 30 days prior to your District Spring conference.
- 4. The District Blue Cap Chair <u>should</u> appoint a committee of 3 former recipients (not from the same Post) throughout the District, to select the District Winner. At the Spring Conference, the District Blue Cap Chair or the District Commander will name and present the winner with the prestigious Blue Cap Pin.
- 5. The Club President will select a committee of 3 former recipients from 3 different districts chosen at the Mid–Winter Conference, who will be mailed the District Winners. After careful review of all District Nominations, in private, they will list on the secret ballot provided, their 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3rd choices. This Secret Ballot, should be mailed to the Blue Cap President, <u>who does not vote</u>. He tallier the votes and confidentially shares the results with the Blue Cap Club Vice President and Secretary/Treasurer.
- 6. The respective District Chair/Commander winner will be notified by the Club President, so as to make every attempt at assuring the presence of the District Winner at their Spring Conference, and be honored and awarded the Blue Cap Pin and encourage to attend the State Convention as a State Nominee.
- 7. The Department Winner, at Convention will be presented the Department Blue Cap Plaque.
- 8. Any Blue Cap Club Member dismissed or expelled from the American Legion will be removed as a Member of the M.C. "MIKE" GEHR CLUB
